GUEST SEATING

All guests will be seated after the Graduand Briefing. This will be approximately 2.50pm. There is no allocated guest seating, however, if you have a guest that needs special assistance with their seating please email the Graduations Team before Friday 7th March 2025.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Sydney Light Rail

The Light Rail travels right through a number of Darling Harbour stations including ICC Sydney's stops, Convention Centre and Exhibition Centre. The Light Rail starts at Central Station in the CBD and travels to Dulwich Hill in the inner west.

Train

A short walk from Central or Town Hall will take you directly to Darling Quarter, Tumbalong Park and Sydney Visitor Centre. Town Hall and Central Stations are a 10-minute walk from ICC Sydney.

Bus

ICC Sydney has its own bus stop. Bus routes 389 and 501 stop at Harris Street near Allen Street - a 10-minute walk from ICC Sydney.

Metro

A short walk from Central or Gadigal Station will take you directly to Darling Quarter Visitor Centre.

PARKING


ICC Sydney has two car park facilities located within the Exhibition Centre and ICC Sydney Theatre, comprising a total of 826 car spaces. Additionally, there are secure car parks located in and around Darling Harbour, including Wilson Harbourside Car Park and First Parking Darling Square Car Park.

Graduand group photo

If you'd like to be part of the official graduand group photo, please arrive at the ICC Forecourt by the Woodward Water Feature at 2:00pm sharp.

While participation is optional, this is a wonderful opportunity to capture a lasting memory with your fellow graduands, marking the culmination of your hard work and dedication.

The group photo session will conclude by 2:20pm sharp. After this, AIB staff will direct you to the Graduand Briefing, ensuring you're fully prepared for the ceremony ahead.



Directions: Start at the Pyrmont Theatre Foyer. Walk through the Parkside Foyer to reach the South East Foyer. Take the escalators down to the Ground Floor. Exit the ICC Sydney through the southern doors (ushers will direct you). Once outside, head towards the Woodward Water Feature. Our meeting spot is on the left-hand side of the water feature when facing the ICC building.



Academic dress and briefing

ACADEMIC DRESS

Your graduation fee includes hiring of a gown, mortar board and hood.

GOWN FITTINGS

Gown Fittings for Ceremony - 11.30am - 2.20pm

In Rooms C2.5 & C2.6 at the ICC Sydney. (Please refer to page 17 for map). We ask that you return your items immediately after the ceremony (unless you are having professional photographs taken) to Rooms C2.5 & C2.6 at the ICC Sydney.

DOCTORATE GOWN FITTINGS

Gown Fittings for Ceremony - 11.30am - 2.20pm

All DBA and PhD Graduands are to be gowned with the Academic staff members in Room C2.4 at the ICC Sydney. (Please refer to page 17 for map). We ask that you return your items immediately after the ceremony (unless you are having professional photographs taken) to Room C2.4 at the ICC Sydney.

All Graduands are required to attend the fitting before the briefing, be dressed and in the Ceremony Hall Pyrmont Theatre by 2.30pm, for the ceremony, at the very latest.

Note: Graduates will be invoiced the full replacement cost of academic regalia if it is not returned. If you are unable to return the regalia yourself, please send a friend or relative to do so on your behalf.



Academic dress and briefing

BRIEFING

Graduands need to arrive at the venue early in order to receive the final briefing and attendance check.

It is important that you are fully gowned and in the Ceremony Hall no later than 2.30pm for the briefing prior to the ceremony.

In the briefing we will discuss the graduation procession to ensure the ceremony runs to perfection. If you arrive later than stated above, we may be unable to allow you to graduate.

Graduands will remain in the Ceremony Hall until the ceremony commences at 3.00pm.

Receiving your parchment

RECEIVING YOUR PARCHMENT ON STAGE

As your parchment and transcript have already been mailed to you in the months following the completion of your degree, official documentation will not be presented to you on the day or your graduation. You will also not be required to bring your parchment or transcript to the ceremony.

Upon walking across the graduation stage, you will be presented with a generic scroll for the purpose of your stage photo. The scroll is yours to keep as a memento and which you can use after your ceremony for personal photos.

DOCTORAL & VALEDICTORIAN GRADUATES

Doctoral Graduate

Once a Doctorate Graduate has been acknowledged on stage they will remain on stage and be seated with the Academics and Board Members already seated on stage. This recognition honours their hard work, dedication and significant contribution to the respective fields.

Valedictorian

Once a Valedictorian has been acknowledged on stage for the completion of their degree they will exit the stage and go straight to the VIP seating in the front row. This is where they will be seated for the remainder of the ceremony, including after they have been presented their Valedictorian Award.



Ceremony details & procedure

GRADUAND SEATING

All graduands will be seated in the Ceremony Hall as per the seating map. You will be seated in the order of awards as per the graduation programme and in alphabetical name order by last name. Please note that your guests are not able to be seated with you in the Ceremony Hall. You will be seated with your fellow graduands. (Please refer to page 12 for seating map)

AWARD PROCEDURE

When your award category is announced, graduands will be called up from their seat, and will be escorted to line up in the Hallway area to have your regalia checked and straightened before entering the stage. When your name is called, you will enter the stage from the left-hand side and exit from the right side stairs before returning to your seat.

All guest seating is general admission. General admission refers to seating areas that are not assigned or reserved and are occupied on a first-come, first-served basis.

STAGE & STUDIO PHOTOGRAPHY

There will be an expert photography team at the graduation, capturing your moment on-stage along with studio shots with your family and friends.

All photography packages can be ordered in the Graduation Portal. Your prints are produced instantly on the day to ensure you can go home with your wonderful memories. We also offer instant high-resolution photo sharing with a link after the ceremony.

FRAMING AND PLAQUES

All our frames are Australian made and are of the highest quality. Since we print your photos instantly, we can mount your photos, Testamur (certificate) or both depending on the frame.

GRADUATION BEARS

We have four graduation toys dressed in your graduation colours. These make a perfect memento, to sit on your desk to remind you of your achievements.

GRADUATION CEREMONY PHOTOGRAPHY

A professional photographer and videographer will be operating during the ceremony. Stage presentation photos will be available for purchase immediately following your ceremony and videos will be posted on the Australian Institute of Business Facebook page and the event will be live streamed via the link in the email already sent.


SCENE TO BELIEVE - GRADUATION PHOTOGRAPHY SERVICE

Graduands will rise when each row is called and approach the stage via the staircase at the left side of the stage. After the graduate has been presented with their certificate, they will return to their seat via the perimeter of the Ceremony Hall and centre aisle.

Frequently asked questions

DO I NEED TO BRING MY TICKETS?

Yes. You will need to either print your tickets or have the Scene to Believe tickets visible on your phone. Tickets will be received via email prior to Graduation Day. Graduand Tickets will be emailed at least 1 week prior to the event.

DOES EVERYONE NEED A SEPARATE TICKET FOR THE GRADUATION CEREMONY AND THEN THE COCKTAIL EVENT IF THEY WISH TO ATTEND?

Yes. Each Graduand and guest needs their own separate Graduation Ceremony ticket and Cocktail Event ticket if they wish to attend both.

CAN I ADD ADDITIONAL GUESTS?

Registrations are closed for any additional guests to attend the ceremony or cocktail event.

WHAT IF I NEED TO LEAVE STRAIGHT AFTER THE CEREMONY BUT WOULD LIKE TO HAVE PORTRAIT PHOTOS TAKEN?

Graduation Photography will be offered from 11.30am. If you would like to utilise this service prior to the graduand briefing, please arrive at 11.30am, to provide sufficient time for gowning and photography.

WHERE DO I RETURN MY GOWN AND HOOD?

Please return your gown and hood to Scene to Believe Graduations Gowning in Meeting Room C2.5 & C2.6 at ICC Sydney no later than 6.00pm. Reminder: As an additional gift, the mortar board worn on the day is yours to keep.

ARE PRAMS PERMITTED IN THE CEREMONY HALL FOR THE CEREMONY?

If you have a pram, ensure it does not block the aisles and escape routes, in the unlikely case of a fire. If prams cannot be placed safely, they will need to be left in the adjoining halls.






ICC site map






ICC site map - Level 1






ICC site map - Level 2
